

# THE TRINITY MISSION



## Testing

While we believe that standardized testing can be a good method for assessing a child's progress from year to year, we do not believe a test should be used to determine a student's success or failure in a grade level. At Trinity, students are tested each year with the Iowa Test of Basic Skills. This test is used as a measure of progress, not as a basis for promotion or retention.

## Class Size

One of the advantages when choosing Trinity is our small class sizes. This enables our educators to work more closely with students in need and challenge students that move at a faster pace. This flexibility to develop students strengths is invaluable and something you won't find in a larger classroom setting.
